Homework will be considered a necessary part of the learning process. Homework must provide sufficient practice time to master the subject matter of the course. A home assignment should be an extension of clearly defined school activities and should be appropriate to the age, ability, and independent level of students. Teachers should assign meaningful homework which fosters lesson enrichment, application, review, and the practice of skills which have been previously taught and learned. Homework should also provide an opportunity for open-ended individual activities encompassing a variety of levels for suitable response and a variety of activities and products.

It should be remembered in all cases that Individual Education Plan (IEP) requirements and the special individual needs of all students supersede the guidelines of this policy.

Because parents are instrumental in encouraging good homework habits and establishing an atmosphere conducive to study, all teachers and administrators must solicit and encourage parental cooperation.

As surely as adults earn and cherish their leisure hours, so do our students. Student leisure time should be considered when developing building level guidelines for homework.
